By defining, applying and maintaining the Environmental management System,

CAPRARI intends to

the more significant impact on the environment caused by its business activities, insofar as this is allowed by the way the services are furnished and by requirements of a financial nature.

CAPRARI particularly directs its efforts towards:

- ❑ OPTIMIZING THE CONSUMPTION OF NATURAL AND ENERGY RESOURCES
- ❑ ACCURATELY MANAGING THE MAINTENANCE ACTIVITIES FOR EQUIPMENT, MACHINES AND INSTALLATIONS
- ❑ IMPROVING THE WAY WASTE IS MANAGED, WITH REFERENCE TO STORAGE AND HANDLING, THE INTENTION BEING TO:
 - REDUCE THE VOLUMES OF WASTE PRODUCED
 - GUARANTEE THAT WASTE IS DISPOSED OF CORRECTLY
 - INCREASE THE USE OF RECYCLED MATERIALS
 - IMPROVE THE STORAGE METHOD
- ❑ SELECTING THE VARIOUS SUBSTANCES USED, WITH PARTICULAR ATTENTION TOWARDS ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT AND THE RISKS THAT USE OF SUCH SUBSTANCES INVOLVES, ALWAYS PREFERRING THOSE WITH A LOW ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT;
- ❑ CONTROLLING ATMOSPHERIC POLLUTION CREATED BY THE OPERATION OF THE MANUFACTURING SYSTEMS;
- ❑ PREVENTING POLLUTION OF THE SOIL AND SUB-SOIL CAUSED BY THE CHEMICALS USED DURING THE MANUFACTURING CYCLE HAVING BEEN SPILT, AS WELL AS CONTAMINATION FROM WASTE;

in normal, anomalous conditions and potential emergency situations.

CAPRARI especially intends to involve and train the staff members so that they may share and take part in the Management System adopted, with particular reference to those whose jobs have a direct influence on the Environmental Management System, and to ensure that those who work on behalf of CAPRARI are aware of these issues.

During the Management's Review, CAPRARI will annually review this Policy and the entire Management System adopted so as to analyze the System's performance trend using specific indicators. It will also define the targets and goals the company proposes to reach in order to implement its Environmental Policy and will arrange for specific plans for attaining these objectives.

CAPRARI hereby informs the named identified parties involved within and outside the company, thereby including customers, suppliers, visitors and all the employees about the aims of the Environmental Policy, which is available if requested and is affixed in the company at the disposal of all concerned.
